

TOWNSHIP OF BRUCE
MINUTES OF MEETING HELD ON NOVEMBER 13, 2014

The regular meeting of the Bruce Township Board was held on November 13, 2014 at the Bruce Township Hall with board members LaJoie, Sawyers, Marsh, Pins and Rogers present. Also in attendance were 2 township residents. The Supervisor called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Public Comments: There were no comments.

The minutes of the October 9, 2014 meeting were presented. Motion was made by Pins, seconded by Rogers to accept the minutes as presented. All were in favor, motion carried.

Motion was made by Rogers, seconded by Pins to pay the bills. Checks # 8129 through # 8168 were presented for a total of \$ 17,382.00. All were in favor, motion carried.

County Commission Report: Commissioner McLean was not present.

Reports of Special Meetings: Supervisor Marsh attended an MTA meeting in Kinross. The speaker spoke on the proposed increase from Cloverland Electric.

Zoning Administrator: There have been 36 permits issued this year.

Assessor's Report: The assessor was unable to attend. The BOR will meet on December 9, 2014 at 7:00 p.m.

Treasurer's Report: The Treasurer's report was read. The balance of all funds is \$874,446.73.

Clerk's Report: Election was held on November 4, 2014. There were 820 voters.

Firemen's Report: There was no report.

Grounds and Park Report: The tables are put away and the dock is out. The bid on a boat launch on Conely's Point is still over by \$187,000.00.

Old Business: At the October 9, 2014 meeting a resolution was passed stating that Bruce Township desires to participate in the Federal Emergency Management Agency's National Flood Plain Insurance Program. Motion was made by Marsh, seconded by Pins to adopt Ordinance # 2014- 1. An Ordinance to designate an enforcing agency to discharge the responsibility of the Township of Bruce, located in Chippewa County, and to designate regulated flood hazard areas under the provisions of the State Code Act. Roll call vote: Yeas, Marsh, LaJoie, Sawyers and Pins. Nays, Rogers. Ordinance adopted.

Motion was made by Marsh, seconded by Pins to appoint Ward Pulfrey and Carolyn Person to the Zoning Board of Appeals. All were in favor, motion carried.

The drawings are done for the Storage Building. The bids will be advertised the first of the year.

New Business: There were no bids returned for the snow plowing at the Township Hall and the Fire Hall. We will keep trying to find someone interested.

Public Comments: There were no comments.

Motion was made by Pins, seconded by Rogers to adjourn the meeting. All were in favor, motion carried. The Supervisor adjourned the meeting at 7:45.
